



Goodwyn Murray Hane

RALEIGH, N.C. – Goodwyn Murray Hane 87, formerly of Columbia, died Saturday January 5, 2008.

He was born April 27, 1920 in Fort Motte, S.C., the fifth child of the late Mae Murray Hane and Thomas Taylor Hane. A graveside service will be held Wednesday at 2 p.m. in Greenlawn Memorial Park; Leesburg Road, Columbia, S.C. Officiating will be the Rev. Charles Davis of Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, Columbia.

Following the death of his father, Hane moved to Columbia with his mother and his siblings. He was a graduate of Columbia High School and The University of South Carolina, where he earned a B.S. Degree in Civil Engineering. He was a lifelong fan of the University of South Carolina Athletics.

Hane was a proud 4-year Veteran of the United States Army, serving in the European Theater during World War II. He was a member of the 36th Division.

Hane was employed as a Civil Engineer by the South Carolina Highway Department and Richland County Government. His first wife, Coles Heyward Douglas and his second wife Virginia Phelps Dupre predeceased Hane.

Surviving are his sons Thomas Taylor Hane III of Raleigh and Robert McGregor Hane of Columbia, S.C.; and grandsons, Nicholas Taylor Hane and Claiborne Roberson Hane, both of Raleigh.
