WARREN, JOSEPH DANIEL, 95, of Crescent Hill, passed away at the St. Matthews nursing Home on Tuesday, September 12, 2006.

He was a native of Hawkinsville, GA; the son of the late Charles T. and Greta G. DuPree Warren Sr. He was a 1933 graduate of University of Georgia Tech with an electrical engineering degree. He also furthered his education at Harvard University, and M. I. T. He retired after 40 years of service as a superintendent of electrical production with L G & E.

He was a major in a special unit attached to the Army/Air Corp of World War II. He was a former member and past president of the Engineering Society. He was recently recognized as a 73-year member of the lodge and a member of Crescent Hill Baptist Church. A long time volunteer with United Crescent Hill Ministries with Meals on Wheels, always visiting with the sick, and as a Red Cross van driver. Joe loved leisure time activities. He bowled for several seasons, was on the L G & E Rifle League, and he also enjoyed boating. His first wife, Dorothy Diefenbach Warren, preceded him in death.

He leaves to cherish his memory his wife, Rachel Bennett - Warren; daughter, Kay W. Keeling (Kenny); his son, Joseph Robert Warren (Donna); four grandchildren, Beth Teaford, Dawn Stearns (Corey), Danny Warren and Matt Warren; and his sister-in-law, Kathrene Bennett.
