She passes away on Wednesday at 4 o'clock suffering a stroke of paralysis in Mar 1921 from which she never recovered. Body laid to rest in the Ten Mile Churchyard.

The loss of her son Lafayette Carter in the World War made her the only gold star mother in Appling Co. This loss of this son marked the decline of her health, which ended in her passing on Wednesday, November 14 at her home in the Hamilton Community. She was the daughter of John Hamilton and Feriby Moody Hamilton. Born in 1869 and married in Dec 1885, Baptist.
