Orvil Glen 'Pete' Stevenson Funeral services for lifelong Mancos resident Orvil Glen 'Pete' Stevenson will be held at 3 p.m. Monday, Dec. 8 at the Trinity Lutheran Church. Interment will follow at the Cedar Grove Cemetery. Pastor David Dahl will officiate.

A visitation has been scheduled before the service at the church beginning at 2 p.m. Pete was born July 26, 1929, in Mancos to Augustus Joel and Etta Lavina (Freeman) Stevenson. He died Wednesday, Dec. 3, 2003, at his home in Mancos at the age of 74.
