W.M. LEWIS WILL BE BURIED THIS MORNING AT OLD HOME

William Minor Lewis, of Montezuma, Ga., died at the Middle Georgia Sanatorium yesterday at 3 o'clock after an illness of several days. He was 47 years of age. The body was taken to his old home yesterday where the funeral will take place at 11 o'clock this morning from his late residence, Rev. Graham Forrester officiating.

At the time of his death Mr. Lewis was president of the Citizens' National Bank of Montezuma, and at one time he was president of the Fourth National Bank of this city.

Besides his wife who was Miss Christine Patrick, he is survived by two daughters, Misses Christine and Louise Lewis; one brother, John F. Lewis, of Valdosta, and two sisters, Mrs. W.D. Dodson, of Americus, and Mrs. John C. Holmes, of Macon.
